

**CURRICULUM FOR LASH & BROW TECHNICIAN**

A.24. The prescribed course of studies and practical training for a Lash & Brow Technician shall consist of not less than **300 hours** of theory and practical instruction, given during a period of not less than six (6) **weeks** by a **certified aesthetic instructor, make-up instructor or lash & brow extension technician instructor to the satisfaction of the Examining & Licensing Committee**. Work experience will not be less than 35 hours.
